

2010 THQMA Track Rules

- No bikes or scooters inside inner perimeter of fence
- No kids allowed to play on paved entrance road
- No golf carts or 4-wheelers within 20 ft. of fence (unless it is in your paid parking spot)
- Must have valid drivers license to operate a golf cart, 4-wheeler, tractor, etc
- No profane or abusive language or gestures
- Must have QMA I.D. Badge to be in hot chute
- No kids or drivers in work area at anytime
- No sitting on fence around the Track surface or Work area
- Only quarter midgets on racing surface
- No smoking inside the fenced in area
- No alcoholic beverages
- No kids on judges stand
- Do not wash tires in Restrooms
- No one under 16 can be in the concession stand
- QMA national code of conduct will be enforced
- Children must be accompanied by adult QMA member in order to sign in
- No Pets allowed outside your designated Parking area (unless used as a Handicapped assisted pet)
- Must be a THQMA member to be able to practice on the Track

2010 THQMA Racing Rules

- Do not approach judges, scorekeeper, or flagman, tower
- Members/handlers may not have individuals removed from judges stand
- All complaints must go to the **race director** within 15 minutes after race
- All cars must scale after each race
- QMA Rules will apply at all times
- Must have corner workers at all times
- Must be ready when it is your race (can't wait for you)
- 20 minute time limit
- Pill draw for position on non points nights
- Will qualify for position on points races
- Judges must be used at all times
- Will use paper #'s
- ❖ Rain-outs will be called 2 hours prior to sign in if possible by track crew and race director; Check website/ answering machine (812) 478-1554

Race Order

Race Director may alter race order as he deems necessary

2010 THQMA Racing Fees and Awards

- Race Fees THQMA members \$15.00 and \$20.00 non members
- There will be a \$15.00 per class point series fee that must be paid by May 28th Points race.
- Must run at least half plus 1 of all paid races at our track for end of year awards
- Must run half plus one of all points races to receive points series awards
- Racing bucks and trophies will be awarded (your choice for season)
- Trophies will be awarded at end of night after tech has been complete
- Members presenting a check that is returned by the bank will be charged a \$25.00 service fee will not be a “member in good standing” and not be allowed to race until rectified. A second check returned within same season will deem that member “cash only” for a period of 1 year

2010 THQMA Concession Stand Rules

- All Full members must pay concession stand buy out prior to seasons first race
- Concession stand buyout fee \$80.00
- Must pay buy out before child / children can race
- Sign up to work concession stand week prior for scheduling, (sign up sheet will be on website)
- You will be reimbursed for time worked when shift is over
- No one under 16 can work concession stand

2010 Tech Rules

- All Cars must weigh after each race
- Top 4 cars from each Main (A,B, C...) will be impounded each night on a Non-Points Night
- Top 4 cars from the A-Mains will be impounded on a Points Night
- Class or classes for tech will be drawn from hat
- *Any car can be teched at directors discretion*
- QMA rules will apply
- Tech cannot be refused
- Only tires can be removed from car after impound
- Impound area is under the tech sheds inside the fenced area
- The fenced in area also is considered impound area
- Leaving the fenced area without being released will be considered refusal of tech

2010 Flower Fund

- 50/50 Drawing each night
- Money will go to flowers, balloons, cards for immediate club family member in need
- Please let a club officer know about any club members needs

2010 Family Race Work Night

- THQMA Families will be scheduled for Family Race Work nights by the President
- If a family does not attend their assigned Family Race Work Night and no substitute was found then said Family Race car or cars will start the next Race night attended on the tail of the lowest main and for all proceeding races.

2010 Track Work Days

- THQMA members must attend at least 1 Track Work Day
- Work Days will be scheduled by the President
- THQMA members who do not attend a Work day forfeit end of the year awards
- Work Days are defined as Track Maintenance, Track Fundraiser or anything approved by the Corporate Board (THQMA arrive and drive is not considered a eligible work day)

THQMA “Member in Good Standing” definition:

All privileges including but not limited to:

Access to all racing areas including hot chute, staging, pit area, racing surface, scale area, flag stand, judges stand, corner worker area, club (and board, if applicable) voting rights.

A member deemed “not in good standing” may regain “good standing” status by complying with requirements set forth by a majority decision of the board of directors.

Members shall lose their “good standing” status when any (but not limited to) of the following obligations are not fulfilled:

- Any obligation as set forth by QMA membership
- Concession fees not paid
- Family work night obligation not met (applies to members w/o children racing)
- Violation of any THQMA track rules
