General Information

Parking

Parking spaces are reserved and cost \$100.00 for the year. This gives you access to the space and electric hook up for the year. They are picked based on seniority at the January meeting. Then, on a first come first serve basis. To keep your seniority, you must pay for your parking space and membership by the end of December for the following year.

Race Director Fee

We utilize a paid, third party race director at as many races as possible. Each family will pay an additional \$5 for each race to pay the race director. (It has been difficult to find a RD; we will keep trying to find a reliable, knowledgeable applicant.)

Transponders & Raceceivers

We utilize both transponders and raceceivers on a weekly basis. Raceceivers are mandatory for all drivers and can be purchased [HERE](#). The club does not have these on hand and they are mandatory for each race. These devices are a one way communication system between the driver and the race director.

We also utilize transponders on a weekly basis. This allows our tower team to use a computer based system to help with scoring. All data is stored on the app, My Race Pass. Transponders can be purchased [HERE](#). (The club currently has a discounted bulk order in process until 12/31/21 [HERE](#). It is best for each family to have their own transponder. There will be a limited supply of transponders available at the track to rent each week.
