## 2022 THQMA MEMBERSHIP PROCESS

The following is an outline of our membership process:

- Contact our club secretary at <u>secretary@thqma.com</u> to complete a THQMA membership application.
- Complete THQMA registration online <u>HERE</u>. <u>Select "Primary Membership"</u>. Membership for a family is \$75.
- Complete a USAC license registration online at <u>www.USAC25license.com</u> and pay USAC dues
- Any alternate handlers that you register through USAC must also purchase a club membership <u>HERE.</u>
- ANY person that wants to enter the hot chute area and/or track must be a registered USAC and club member.
- Receive welcome letter and USAC licensing card
  - USAC cards will be mailed to local club secretary for distribution once the season begins.
- Attend club meetings on the second Thursday of each month and specially held club meetings as announced (January meeting TBD) This is where we vote on a schedule and select parking spots. You don't want to miss this meeting!
- Become familiar with track rules, track schedule, USAC rules and racing procedures at <u>www.thqma.com</u>.
- Stay in the know with email, text alerts and Facebook. THQMA also has Twitter and Instagram accounts.
- Other fees:
  - o \$100.00 optional annual parking fee
    - Allows access to electricity and parking space for the year
    - Spaces are reserved and based on club seniority
    - Spaces are selected at the January meeting, and then first come first serve after that.
    - You may park in an available space that has not been reserved, but you may not access the electricity without paying for the space. If this space



becomes reserved by another member, you will not be able to continue to park there.
