TERMS OF AGREEMENT WITH THQMA

- THE CAR REMAINS THE PROPERTY OF TERRE HAUTE QUARTER MIDGET ASSOCIATION.
- EACH DRIVER WILL BE LOANED A CAR IN RACE READY CONDITION. THE CAR (MOTOR, TIRES, PIT CART) IS THE PROPERTY OF THQMA AND MUST BE RETURNED IN LIKE CONDITION AT THE END OF THE SEASON.
- THE CAR WILL BE RETURNED ONE WEEK AFTER THE SEASON IS COMPLETE.
- YOU MUST COME TO ALL ARRIVE AND DRIVE EVENTS TO HELP AND PROMOTE THE PROGRAM FOR THE YEARS TO FOLLOW.
- YOU MUST RUN THE MOTOR LOANED TO YOU BY THQMA FOR THE SEASON.
- THE RECIPIENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE THROUGHOUT THE SEASON. FAILURE TO MAINTAIN THE CAR/MOTOR IN AN ACCEPTABLE RACING CONDITION, AS SO DETERMINED BY THQMA'S ROOKIE AND SAFETY DIRECTORS, WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP CAR.
- ROOKIE FAMILY MUST BE ABLE TO TRANSPORT CAR TO AND FROM THE TRACK AND SAFELY STORE THE CAR.
- YOU MUST ATTEND/PARTICIPATE IN AT LEAST $\frac{3}{4}$ OF THE SCHEDULED THQMA RACES DURING THE SEASON. MISSING 2 RACES IN A ROW WOULD REVOKE YOUR AGREEMENT AND CAR WOULD BE RETURNED FOR USE BY ANOTHER DRIVER.
- YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PURCHASE OF YOUR OWN APPROVED SAFETY GEAR (HELMET, NECK COLLAR, ARM RESTRAINTS, SUIT, AND GLOVES)
- YOU MUST ATTEND 3 ROOKIE CLASSES PRIOR TO BEING ABLE TO RACE, AND A MINIMUM OF 1 IN A 2 WEEK PERIOD THEREAFTER. ALL ROOKIE PRACTICES ARE FREE TO THQMA MEMBERS.
- YOU ARE REQUIRED TO JOIN THQMA & BE A MEMBER OF USAC, THQMA'S SANCTIONING BODY, (YEARLY FEES; \$75 CLUB & \$100.00 + \$10/INS TO USAC)
- YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE NIGHTLY RACING FEE OF \$25.
- THE CARS MUST STAY PAINTED AND DECALED AS RECEIVED FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON. (NO ADDITIONAL DECALS OR STICKERS CAN BE ADDED)
- OIL MUST BE CHANGED REGULARLY AND NO OTHER WORK CAN BE DONE ON THE ENGINE BESIDES CHANGING VALVE SPRINGS.
- DO NOT CUT OR WELD ON CAR WITHOUT FIRST TALKING TO THE PRESIDENT AND/OR THE BOD.
- IF YOU PRACTICE/RACE ON PAVEMENT, YOU MUST RUN THE HOOSIER A-35 TIRES ON THE RIGHT SIDE. THE HOOSIER D-10 OR D-30 MAY NOT BE USED ON PAVEMENT ON THE RIGHT SIDE.
- ON DIRT, YOU MAY RUN D-10, D-30 OR A-35 ON THE RIGHT SIDE.
- CAR MAY BE SUBJECT TO WEEKLY INSPECTIONS PRIOR TO RACING.

- CAR IS PROVIDED WITH A PIT CART, SEAT BELTS, AND TIRES.
- FAMILIES MUST PURCHASE A RACECEIVER AND THERE WILL BE A TRANSPONDER FEE IF YOU CHOOSE NOT TO BUY ONE.
- AT ANY POINT THE MOTOR IS TORN DOWN FOR INSPECTION, THE MOTOR MUST COME BACK TO THQMA FOR ASSEMBLY. ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE MOTOR IS RETURNED.

I AGREE TO THE ABOVE CONDITIONS AND UNDERSTAND THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM COULD BE REVOKED BY THE THQMA BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR ANY VIOLATIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT.
